 - 1.2 Mystic Air Quality conducted an inspection of the building and is investigating further one area of possible concern on the lower level regarding acoustical tile glue and will provide a complete report.

- 2.1 The real estate closing for the Ocean Avenue property can be done electronically or in person with the Synagogue. October 20th is the tentative date for the closing. All Synagogue staff will be physically out of the building by October 31, 2017 and will be responsible for any expenditures and insurance.  - 3.2 Tecton and O & G will be conducting a site visit on September 22, 2017 and will learn about the population of students that this building will serve.
