Special Education Concentration (*optional***)**

In collaboration with the Department of Special Education at CCSU, we are able to offer a unique concentration within the Sixth Year program for educators interested in specializing some of their leadership coursework in the area of Special Education. Three courses (EDL 605, EDL 620, and EDL 630) may be substituted with three alternative versions of those classes that focus more specifically on Special Education:

SPED 605 Special Education Leadership in Teaching and Learning SPED 620 Collaborative Leadership for Special Education Leaders SPED 630 Special Education Law, Ethics & Equity

For students interested in this option, these courses are taken separately from the rest of the cohort courses.

Admissions Requirements

- Master's Degree from regionally accredited institution of higher education
- 3.00 minimum GPA in post-baccalaureate courses; 2.7 undergraduate GPA
- Minimum of 3 years teaching experience
- Possession or eligibility for a CT teaching certificate

Obtaining the 092 Certificate

- Complete all coursework with a 3.00 GPA or better.
- Successful completion of the Connecticut Administrator Test (CAT)
- Complete and submit CSDE form 170a
