NONDISCRIMINATION

The conditions or privileges of employment in this organization, including the wages, hours, terms, and benefits shall be applied without regard to race, color, religious creed, sex, age, national origin, ancestry, marital status, sexual orientation, disability (including, but not limited to, mental retardation, past or present history of mental disability, physical disability or learning disability), genetic information, gender identity or expression or any other basis prohibited by Connecticut state and/or federal laws and provides equal access to designated youth groups except in the case of a bona fide occupational qualification or need. Neither the board nor any employee nor any other person may aid or compel the performance of an unfair practice as defined by law.

DISCIPLINE

No employee will be disciplined, reprimanded, reduced in rank, or deprived of any professional advantage without just cause and due process.

GRIEVANCES

No employee, employee association representative, member of any employee organization, or any other participant in a grievance procedure shall suffer reprisals in any way or suffer any professional disadvantage by reason of his/her being opposed to any unfair employment practice or because of his/her participation in the processing of any grievance. The Executive Director will provide procedures for alleged violations of Board policies, of administrative regulations, of unfair employment practices, and operations in general when not otherwise covered in employee organization agreements.
